

PREVAILING WAGE CONTRACTOR REGISTRY

The New York State Department of Labor (NYS DOL) has launched the new Prevailing Wage Contractor Registry.



If you do prevailing wage work in New York State, **starting December 30, 2024, registration with the NYS DOL is required** to bid on or perform covered prevailing wage work.



You are responsible for ensuring that **all subcontractors** on a covered project are registered.

ACT NOW

The NYS DOL estimates that the registration could take 3-4 weeks, so it's important to register **NOW**.
